

CEO of NMP to step down

The Board of Network of Music Partners (NMP) has today announced that NMP CEO, Malin Skogman Jonsson, is stepping down after more than seven years in the role and will be leaving NMP by the end of the year.

In order to ensure the smoothest continuation for the organisation, CIO Tine Oswald will step up and take over the CEO position, upon returning from maternity leave on December 6th. And Mark Steven will be deputy CEO to support Tine on the offline.
